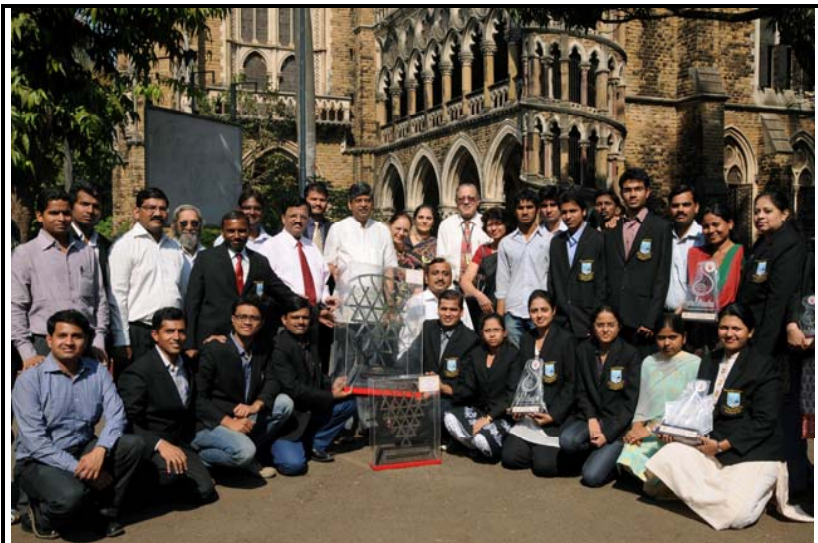

Competition held on 15th Jan 2012 at Shivaji University University Kolhapur.

All 19 Universities participated in the said convention. Mumbai University qualified 23 projects. While in the Oral Presentation all the research convention Mumbai University superseded Pune University and won the Over All Championship with five Gold and Six Silver Medals.

His Excellency the Governor of Maharashtra is organising various competitions to promote untapped talent of the students in the State of Maharashtra. Since last five years the State Competition has organised in various Universities in the category of :

1: Humanities, Languages and Fine Arts etc. 2: Commerce, Management and Law
3 : Pure Sciences, 4: Agriculture and Animal Husbandry, Engineering and Technology, 6 : Medicine and Pharmacy, at the four levels viz: (a) Under-graduate, (b) Post-graduate, (c) Ph. D. and (d) Teachers Pursuing Ph.D.

Every University is supposed to send two entries in each category and each level.

The total contingent of 48 Research Scholars is expected to participate at the Research Convention at the State Level. Mumbai University had begun its process

of Research Convention since 23rd December, 2011, and concluded the Qualifying Rounds on 30th December, 2011. The Final Round of the said competition was held on 4th and 5th January, 2012, wherein all more than 700 projects were received and assessed in whole process. The contingent of 44 from the University participated at the **State Level Research Convention Avishkar 2011, between 13th to 15th January, 2012**, at Shivaji University, Kolhapur.
