**Revised Admission Schedule of the second round for the M. Sc. Degree (Credit-based Semester System) course in Chemistry**

**The second round of admissions which was scheduled to be held on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> August 2011 had to be postponed because of heavy rains leading to transport problem. The same will now be held on Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2011 in the seminar room of the Department as per the following schedule:**

**The student who has obtained the choice of his/her branch in the first round and the student who has cancelled the admission obtained in the first round will not be considered for the second round.**

**The allotment will be done strictly as per the merit list for each category, subject to the availability at the time mentioned in the schedule. The applicant must be present in person at the time mentioned in the schedule failing which he/she will forfeit the claim for admission.**

**Applicant who has been allotted a seat in the second round is required to follow the following procedure strictly to confirm the admission.**

- 1. Submit the original Statement of Marks of T. Y. B. Sc. Examination.**

2. In case of reserved category students, the original caste certificate should be brought for verification.
3. In case of OBC/SBC/NT/DT candidates, a non-creamy layer certificate for the current financial year (2011-12) should be submitted in original.
4. If the candidate fails to produce the required certificates in original at the time of admission, he/she will forfeit the claim for admission.
5. The prescribed fee of Rs. 1875/- [Tuition fee Rs. 1000/- + Registration fee Rs. 850/- + Cost of the form of Registration Rs. 25/-] should be paid in the Allahabad Bank, Kalina Branch, Wadia High School compound, Ground Floor, Opposite Vidyanagari Campus on the same or following day. (For SC/ST students the prescribed fee is Rs. 875/- [Registration fee Rs. 850/- + Cost of the form of Registration Rs. 25/-]).
6. **The Department copy of the challan with the stamp of the bank should be returned to the Department office on or before Saturday, 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2011, failing which the candidate will forfeit the claim for admission.**
